Year 5 – Outdoor Learning Group



On Tuesday afternoon, our Year 5 outdoor learning group had an afternoon of exploration and discovery at Gwithian Towans, getting close to nature. They began their nature journey with a walk up to a high point where they used binoculars to observe the area, a compass to get a sense of direction and a detailed map of the area to find key features. The children also used weather

instruments to record the wind speed and temperature. They were fascinated by the amount of rabbit warrens and badger setts that they discovered in this area. They continued their journey and


stopped to relax in the marram grass where the children listened to nature, and learned more about the creatures that live there. A sand

dune 'blow out' was their next stop where they learned about

the formation of sand dunes while creating their own dune system. Throughout the journey the children also used a variety of magnifiers and lenses to observe what they had discovered. They all had a thoroughly enjoyable time.











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Year 5/6 Football Festival

On Wednesday night the year 5 and 6 Connor Downs football team had a tournament at mounts bay school. It was 3:30 until 5:30 we took 2 mini buses. Mr Pascoe drove one bus



and Mr Costello drove the other bus. One team was wearing a short sleeve top and the other team was wearing a long sleeve top. The short sleeve top was navy with a white stripe down the side and the long sleeve top was navy with white arms. When we got there we put our boots on. Then we had a picture of the team. Five minutes before the games started we all got in a line of our teams. The person who was running the tournament told us how long the games would be and who we were playing. There were

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Year 5 - Nexus Workshop



On Thursday, the children from Year 5 attended a workshop at Nexus on Gears, Levers and Pulleys. They were tasked with finding out if a longer lever is better than a shorter lever when lifting the same mass. In order for it to be a fiar test, they used the same length of wood, the same mass (200g), the same Newton Meters and equally spaced holes. They found that as the lever got longer it was easier to lift the mass.



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
