<u>Year 1 – Penlee Museum</u>

Last Friday, Year 1 visited Penlee Museum where they took part in an 'Old Toys' workshop. This linked with their history topic this term 'Toys Past and Present'. The children had a great time being shown some very old toys that, due to their age, they were not able to physically touch but, they were able to explore and play with old wooden toys and toys from the 1990's. It was really exciting, and we would like to say a huge thank you to the adults who supported the trip to make it possible.









Year 5/6 – STEM Workshop

On Monday and Tuesday, Year 6 and Year 5 respectively enjoyed a STEM workshop held by Megan Page, who is in the NAVY and based at RNAS Culdrose.

She talked to the children about her recent trips to the Caribbean to monitor storm activity and take part in turtle conservation projects. Megan answered lots of questions from the children. Her talk should inspire them to be adventurous in their lives and to care for others.





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The children enjoyed learning how 230 people aboard the HMS Dauntless live in close proximity, how important the 'mess' is and that sometimes, on board, they get Magnum ice-creams!

Year 4 Dunes visit



Last Thursday, the Year 4 outdoor learning group had an amazing afternoon of exploration and discovery at Gwithian Towans. They used binoculars, a compass and a map to get a sense of direction before heading into a sand dune 'blow out' to learn about the formation of sand dunes. They



discovered rabbit warrens, badger setts and observed objects that they found closely using a variety of magnifiers. From a high point they also measured the wind speed and temperature using an anemometer. The children had silent time while relaxing in the marram grass, listening for

Sky Larks and other birds. Finally, the children thoroughly

enjoyed running down the sand dunes.
