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<u>Lego League STEM Equipment - Can you help?</u>

We are planning on running an extra-curricular club for children in Years 5 and 6, working towards participation in the Lego League finals in Cornwall. Taking part in the Lego League will introduce the children to designing, building and programming their LEGO robot in order to use it to complete a series of missions. They will have to research the annual theme, design a solution and develop a presentation. The children will also be expected to demonstrate

the LEGO League Core Values which include innovation, teamwork, inclusion, impact, fun, discovery and respect. We believe that involvement in this event will be very beneficial to our children and give them the confidence they need to navigate our increasingly digital world effectively and successfully. It also gives them the opportunity to access this exciting arena which will open their eyes to the many opportunities in STEM occupations.

Unfortunately, there are substantial costs involved in getting a Lego League club set up. There is the initial outlay for the Lego equipment (@£450) and the yearly registration fee (£170 this year). Teams usually get t-shirts printed too for the competition.

For showing such confidence to be first to stand in front of the class to give a presentation. Well done, Toby!


Character – Henry (Year 5)
