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




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English

Year 1 have been busy developing our writing skills this term. We then read the stories The Jolly Christmas Postman and Paddington's Christmas Post, which helped us write our letters to Santa.





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
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Maths

Year 1 have spent most of this term looking at place value and addition and subtraction with 10. Before half term we focused on number formation every morning and making number bonds to 5 and 10 as part of our spiral maths.

The first area Year 1 have covered in maths is place value within 10, this was done through sorting, counting and representing objects and counting objects from a larger group. Once we were confident with these skills, we moved on to recognising numbers as words, counting forwards and backwards within 10, finding 1 more and 1 less and using a number line. We finally focused on comparing numbers and groups, ordering objects and numbers using fewer, more and the same to describe them and we looked at greater than, less than and equal to.





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For the second half term we have looked at addition and subtraction facts within 10 using part-whole models and our number bonds to help us. We looked at adding or subtracting using a number line, finding a part and using crossing out to help us with subtraction sums. We finally spent some time before Christmas looking at shape, we looked at different 2d and 3d shapes and making patterns with shapes. Some of Year 1 enjoyed some maths on the move sessions with Mr Costello finding lots of different shapes in our outside space at school.



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Science

In science we have had a look at different materials, their properties and matching materials to the correct labels. We have also looked at what materials would be best for certain parts of a house; we decided glass is best for the windows because it is waterproof and we can see through it. We have also looked at seasonal changes, we named the different seasons, focused on the changes that occur and looked at how animals and humans adapt to













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History




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
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


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Art and Design Technology

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

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
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Geography

where we live describing and drawing what it is like.






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<u>RE</u>


