Their behaviour and determination to do their best was exemplary and they thoroughly enjoyed taking part in a range of events.


"I was excited! The tag rugby was my favourite activity", said Kerra.

"I loved it!" exclaimed Peyton. "The football was my best activity as I enjoyed kicking the ball to score goals for my team."














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Year 3 Penlee Gallery and Museum





Year 3 had an amazing experience on Tuesday at Penlee Museum and Gallery learning all about the Stone Age.



They learned about the chronology of the stone age period, handled replicas of stone age pots, arrow heads and drinking cups.



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Later the children viewed real artefacts on display found by archaeologists in West Cornwall. The children learnt how to make a copper badge with a bronze age design. In the afternoon they visited the gallery to see the Newlyn School paintings on display.
