


Dear parents/carers,

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Outdoor Learning




This week in our outdoor learning sessions, Year 4 have been learning about pollination and the importance of insects. They carefully dissected a daffodil to

back into the pond, hopefully helping them towards the next stage of their lives. Finally, they observed a bumble bee closely using different lenses and a microscope.









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














Coats/Spare Shoes

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

If your child needs any school uniform items, please do come along and see what you can pick up. The friends just kindly ask for a small donation in return.






Free Vegetables - Sponsored by Riviera Produce

Reminder: In an effort to raise funds, the Friends of Connor Downs Academy have arranged a Bags2School collection for Tuesday 21st March.



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
