On Monday some of our Year 5 and 6 children, represented Connor Downs Academy at a Mutli-Skills Festival at Mounts Bay Academy.


Their behaviour and determination to do their best was exemplary and they thoroughly enjoyed taking part

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Year 4 Camborne Science and International Academy – Climbing and Orienteering



On Thursday, Year 4 went to Camborne Science and International Academy to be taught how to use their climbing wall, work as part of a team and develop their orienteering skills. For the first activity, half of the class worked with a teacher from CSIA to put on harnesses and helmets and support each other on the climbing wall while the other half




of the class worked with Mrs Crease who challenged them to work



collaboratively as a team with different activities. The groups then swapped over. During the afternoon, the class were taken outside to be taught how to follow a map to find control points and collect the information they needed. The letters found were an anagram

of 'football'. Mrs Crease was very impressed with how well the class worked in their teams both in the team challenges and while they followed their maps during the orienteering activity.

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




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Sponsored Reading Event

Good luck to everyone – next week, you could be the lucky of winner of the elf!

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


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Shine Celebrations
