

Please note, signing up to this Cashpot will not affect your own Cashpot earn.



Important - Changes to collection for Years 3 and 4

From Monday next week, 9th September, there will be a slight change to where Year 3 will be collected at the end of the day.

For morning drop off all the children in Year 3 and 4 will continue to enter the school via the granite steps at the bottom of the school near the main gates.

At the end of the school day, Year 4 will still be collected from these steps, where they will line up in register order and filter out one at a time to the parent/carer collecting them.

Year 3 will now be collected from the back door where they will be dismissed, again in register order to their respective parent/carer.

We hope that this change will make it smoother and quicker for all parents/carers and staff when dismissing.

Parents/carers of Year 3 should congregate at the top of the playground where they can be easily seen by the Year 3 staff who will come out and stand at the top of the steps by the back door.

Please can we ask Year 3 parents/carers not to block the steps or the ramp to ensure the parents/carers of children in Years R, 1 and 2 can easily leave after collecting their children.

Thank you for your support with this and hope that this change will make collection a little smoother and quicker at the end of the school day.
