We are all winners after all. Some people like doing this and some people don't like to run, throw or even jump but some people's dream is to be an athlete. And I am a retired British athlete as a men's triple jumper.

Vortex throw: my furthest was 10 metres in the throwing. Long jump: I did 1.06m for the long jump. 75 metre: sprint in about 25 seconds. 400m: I did the 400m in 2 minutes and 30 seconds.

of them all. Well done Team Connor Downs! Thank you to Mr Viner and Mrs Holmes for their support.




Art
