Year 6 – Hayle Academy Transition Day




This week, Year 6 were invited to Hayle Academy to take part

opportunity for the children to prepare for the next stage of their education. Thank you to Hayle for inviting us!







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


Art Club News


Art club got off to a great start this week with the children from Years 1 – 4 creating pictures about road safety.

For being such a great role model in class, always showing such kindness and a willingness to support everyone. Well done, Amelia!


