


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

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




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World Book Day








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Year 6 enjoying World Book Day.

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Emergency Services visit to teach children from each class key life skills.




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I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your support this term in ensuring that your child/ren are in school every day, ready and eager to learn. We appreciate all that you do.
