



The tree of Chanack


The focus of PE this term for Year 3 is to look at what makes an effective team, with the focus on problem solving games.

Census Day Lunch

On Thursday, May 15, 2025, we observe National School Census Day, a crucial event where the Department for Education (DfE) gathers vital information from every school. This data aids in future planning and plays a pivotal role in determining school budgets.

One significant data point we must report is the count of Reception, Year 1, and Year 2 students partaking in Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) on this specific day. The information collected during the census influences the allocation of funding for our school's hot meal program throughout the year. It's essential to note that if your child doesn't participate in the meal service on May 15th, it impacts our funding for the remainder of the year. Should your child opt to have a meal on any other day, we must cover the cost from our school budget, as funding is solely based on meal consumption during the designated census days in October and January and May, annually.
