Parent/carer communication – Whats App and other social media platforms

It is our aim, that all children feel happy and safe at school and that they flourish both socially and academically.

At times, especially around transition when staring school or moving to a new year group, children can require additional support whilst settling and learning new routines and expectations. This can cause upset or uncertainty for the children and in turn the parents/carers.

We operate an 'Open door' policy and urge all parents/carers to share their concerns with the class teacher in the first instance. This can be verbally, via email using the school email account <u>hello@connordowns.org.uk</u> or during a face to face mutually convened meeting. The vast majority of concerns can be quickly addressed by the teacher and through working collaboratively with the parent/carer.

Where concerns remain outstanding, an appointment can be made to meet with myself as Head of School, SENDCo and DSL.

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Please can I urge all parents/carers to utilise this school communication offer for the benefit of your child/children. I understand that many parents/carers within the school community use various social media platforms, including Whats App, to communicate with fellow parents/carers. This method of communication can cause unnecessary anxiety for parents/carers. Please always speak to your class teacher. We are here to help and will endeavour to address any concerns raised through the appropriate school channels of communication.
