### Year 4 – Group 1 Dunes Visit

Year 4 group 1 had an amazing afternoon of exploration and discovery at Gwithian Towans. They used binoculars, a compass and a map to get a



sense of direction before heading into a sand dune 'blow out' to learn about the formation of sand dunes. They continued on their journey observing rabbit warrens, badger setts and learning more about the creatures that live here. From a high point they also measured the wind speed using an anemometer. The children had silent time while relaxing in the marram grass, listening for Sky Larks and other birds. Finally, they used lenses and magnifiers to observe nature.


### Hayle Heritage Centre
