I hope that you and your families are well. We have had a very busy and exciting week.





Hollins for supporting the children on our visit.





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
Year 6 - Baking

For recording the greatest number of steps in a week using the Moki Fitness Trackers. Lola-Grace's total was 29,708 steps. Well done Lola-Grace!


