After lunch, we explored the house. There were lots of animals heads on the walls. There were also pictures that moved when you changed your angle. The pictures were of the


children who lived in the house years ago. They showed the children growing up. The trees around the yard were cut perfectly'.

breakthrough team.



For winning his heat and representing the school at the swimming gala. Well done, Charlie!


Character – Conor (Year 1)


For being a kind, caring, considerate friend to everyone. Conor is an excellent role model as he always follows the school rules. Well done, Conor!
