at the wide variety of cannons at the Castle. They explored four different artefact boxes which showed how letters were sent, how medicine was used, how candles

and blade lights were used and the range of materials used for eating.

Year 1 also learnt about the different people who would have worked and lived in the Castle from Gunners, The Governor, Potboys and Blacksmiths and got to try on the outfits they would have worn. Everyone had an

amazing time discovering all about the history of Pendennis Castle. We


Garden Club – Sensory Area
