Year 5 recently visited Geevor Mine. Here is Lois' report:

'We have been learning about tin mining in Cornwall and to enhance our knowledge and understanding, we embarked on an educational visit to Geevor Tin Mine.



First, we entered the cinema room to watch some videos of the miners. Next, we saw the sheave wheels of Geevor and we went in the "dry". In the pictures, you can see the sign board and explosives schedule and the old locker room where the exminers kits still remain.

On our tour, we tried drilling granite using a hand tool, crushing rock like a bal maiden and carrying the hand cart- a job that would have been my job in the past.

After that, we had a look at the lifts the miners travelled in to get to the mine. Here's a photo of some of us in the lift.



Then, it was time to go to the mine! It was dark and long. Luckily, we had hard hats on because we all kept hitting our heads!

And then, we did sieving. They (Geevor Tin Mine staff) put crystals in the sand and we used the sieves to get the crystals out. All the crystals we got we put in a bag to keep'.
