
EYFS/KS1 Sponsored Sports Event

> just over £600 towards our new reading resources which is fantastic! Please can we ask that any remaining sponsorship money be paid in via ParentPay by the end














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Year 3 – Stem Visit

Year 3 had an exciting afternoon on Tuesday with a visit from Megan who is a member of the Royal Navy based at Culdrose.

Megan explained to the children about her life and role in the Navy as a

weather forecaster.

The children were very interested to hear all about life at sea on the ship and the different countries that Megan had visited. It was brilliant to see the children

asking mature questions and many decided that they would like to join the navy in the future!





Art Club had a great session learning how to make reflections in landscapes. They used wax crayons and oil pastels to create a wax resist to achieve great effects.

Year 4 – Stem Visit

On Wednesday, Year 4 had a special visitor: Megan, from the Royal Navy, came to visit to tell us about STEM and

her job as a meteorologist.

We learned how it would feel if we travelled to a different country and she told us about the opportunities and sports you can do in the Navy, like netball, bob sledging and skiing. Megan told us about life onboard

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ship and how she shared a cabin with six people. We learned that 230 people could be onboard HMS Dauntless. Megan talked to us about how she stays safe onboard ship and about the regular

training sessions. During a recent man-overboard training session, a shark was sighted!

Megan also explained how the Navy can support you in going to university and described the different roles and subjects available.

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




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Year 5 – Life Skills Visit





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
